13. What purposes, besides the obvious, did raising Lazarus achieve?

15.	Was Jesus aware that raising Lazarus would provoke them as such?
16.	Who led the trap to be set that will lead to Jesus' death on the cross?
17.	Why did Jesus go to "Ephraim" (John 11:54) instead of Jerusalem?
